



## Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs): **Peneraju Skil - Inspektor Kimpalan**

### About the Program

**1. What is this program about? What does it aim to achieve?**

This program aims to increase the number of Bumiputera Welding Inspector with CSWIP 3.1 certification in the Oil & Gas industry.

**2. Who is this program for?**

- Malaysian Bumiputera
- Not more than 40 years old at the time of application
- Holder of CSWIP 3.0 with minimum of 2 years working experience
- Welder / Welding Instructor / Foreman / Supervisor with minimum of 5 years working experience

**3. What's unique about this program?**

Opportunity to earn high income with CSWIP 3.1 Welding Inspector certification.

**4. Is this a scholarship or loan program?**

The Peneraju Skil – Inspektor Jurukimpal is a full scholarship programme.

**5. Is this program offered in all states in Malaysia?**

Yes.

**6. How about employment? Will there be employment as part of this program offering?**

Yes, employment is part of the program offering. You may continue working with existing employer or receive better offer from other employers.

**7. How many spots is YPPB offering under this program?**

There are 50 spots to fill. However, the final number of scholarships that will be offered is subject to the quality and calibre of the qualified candidates' pool we receive each year.

**8. Would I be bonded with YPPB after I have finished the program? If yes, how many years would the bond be in effect?**

No. Scholars who have completed the program will not be bonded by YPPB. However, scholars are required to work in Malaysia, or if outside of Malaysia, scholars are required to work with a Malaysian company for at least 1 year after completion of the programme.

**9. Am I required to commit to any kind of official contract/ agreement?**

Yes. A contract will be established.

**10. Would I be able to reject the offer if I am shortlisted?**

Yes, as long as the program's Letter of Offer has not been signed and delivered to PenerajuEdu.

**11. What are the consequences I would face, should the contract be breached?**

Scholars who withdraw from the program are required to payback all costs incurred up to the point of breach to PenerajuEdu.

**12. What does the loan/scholarship cover?**

- Full training fees
- Full exam fees (Allows a maximum of 1 reseat only)

**13. If I receive another loan/scholarship, am I still eligible to receive YPPB loan/scholarship?**
